() Our new landscape schedule for 360 ECO Solutions 360 ECO is on the job, however, it will take time before they are on a schedule that can be followed because of all the corrections they must make to bring our landscape issues to volition. Different crews are performing tasks in their area of expertise. Make note of any landscape concerns you have and forward them to McNeil via our online Landscape Issue Forms. Let's be patient and allow 360 ECO time to correct what has been neglected in the past.

Turf Maintenance (52 visits annually)

- -All turf areas mowed approximately forty-five (45) times annually; weekly March through November; December through February-every other week.
- -All areas bordering driveways, curbs, sidewalks and inanimate objects will be mechanically edged, and blown or swept weekly.
 - -Grass areas around trees, buildings and other obstacles where a mower

cannot reach will be trimmed with a weed-eater with each mowing.

-All fallen leaves will be removed or mulched by lawn mower with each cutting.

Shrubbery & Bed Care

- -Shrubs and other ground cover will be trimmed every other week from April-September and once a month from October-March.
 - -All beds will be kept weed, leaf and debris free weekly.
- -Planter beds will be cultivated every other week for weed control and will be mechanically deep edged with every turf cutting.
 - -All trimming and other debris will be removed from the community.

Irrigation Maintenance

- -Monthly inspections of sprinkler system; heads will be checked, cleaned and adjusted to ensure coverage of all areas.
- -Timers will be set with appropriate watering times for the season or weather pattern.

Fertilization & Insecticide

-Apply fertilizer, insecticide and fungicide if needed to turf monthly, shrubs and palms quarterly and trees annually. Shrubs will be treated with a pre-emergent once per year. Palms and two Medjools will receive a deep root and OTJ injection twice per year.

Mulch

-For additional price deliver and install mulch one time per year.

Tree & Palm Trimming

-Trim all trees and prune all palm trees once per year. We will also trim any low hanging branches found during regularly scheduled maintenance visits.

Annuals

- -Flowers will be planted quarterly with fresh soil amendments.
- () Pet Stations are now available in PT-II for disposing of your animal's feces along Panther Trace Blvd.

 - 1. Remove and place in a sink full of hot water, dishwashing liquid, and baking soda; allow to soak for 10-15 minutes.
 - 2. If needed, scrub the remaining grease off with a brush and rinse clean using hot water.
 - 3. Dry the filter with a paper towel before replacing.


