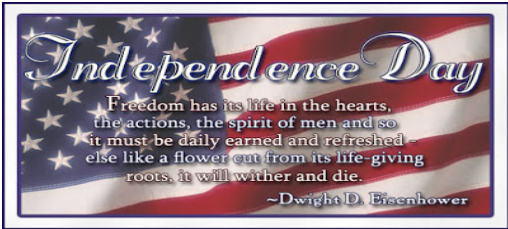

IN CONGRESS, JULY 4, 1776.
A DECLARATION
BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,
IN GENERAL CONGRESS ASSEMBLED.

WE hold these Truths to be self-evident, "that all Men are created equal;" that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness—That to secure these Rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just Powers from the Consent of the Governed, that whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these Ends, "it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to substitute a new Government, laying its Foundation on such Principles, and organizing its Powers in such Form, as to them shall appear most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness." In extending, indeed, with solemn thanksgivings to God, the Preamble of the Constitution, we are reminded that the Union should not be changed for light and transient Causes, and accordingly in Expressions that are more dignified to suffer, while such are endured, than to change themselves by abolishing the Forms to which they are accustomed. But when a long Train of Abuses and Misuses, proving themselves to be injurious to the People, shall have accumulated, so that a Reform in the Structure of the Government shall appear to be necessary, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to substitute a new Government, laying its Foundation on such Principles, and organizing its Powers in such Form, as to them shall appear most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness.

The Fourth Of July is a time to celebrate our freedom and how far we have come.

1. The Declaration of Independence began as a letter to King George to explain why the Continental Congress voted to declare independence from Great Britain.
2. The Declaration of Independence was started on July 2 July 1776 and the Continental Congress approved the final wording on 4 July. The American colonies were declared free and independent states.
3. The first Independence Day was celebrated on 8 July 1776 and the official signing took place on 2 August.
4. Fifty-six (56) people signed the Declaration of Independence. Thomas Jefferson wrote most of it.
5. The first Independence Day on 8 July 1776 took place in Philadelphia. The White House celebrated Independence Day for the first time in 1804.
6. The Declaration has five (5) parts; (1) The Preamble, (2) Statement of Human Rights, (3) Charges Against Human Rights, (4) Charges Against the King and Parliament, and (5) The Statement of Separation and Signatures.
7. According to census.gov, 2.5 million people celebrated the first Independence Day, compared to 316.2 million people today.
8. July 4 was officially declared a holiday in 1870, nearly one hundred (100) years after the Declaration of Independence was written.
9. Currently, the oldest Independence Day celebration in the U.S. is held in Bristol, Rhode Island.
10. This year, 2019 marks the 243rd Independence Day.
