According to our Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Panther Trace Villas the following is for your information: Article II Property Rights, Section 12 Maintenance (a) Responsibility of Association (i) the exclusive right of the Association to conduct grounds maintenance,,,, exclusive control means the Owners of the Lots shall not be required, or entitled, to conduct such activities,,,,the Association shall have sole discretion as to the timing and necessity of maintenance activities, it being the intent of the Association to control such activities...

Note: The Owner's responsibility ends with the submission of a Landscape & Irrigation Request Form via the Resident Portal to McNeil.

Safety, Security and Maintenance:

• Posted speed limit while driving through the Villas is 15 MPH

- Your help is needed in keeping the restrooms clean, neat, and tidy at the pool. Please refrain from throwing paper towels in the commode. Additionally, please clean up after yourself.
- **Parents**, please encourage your children to use the sidewalks and not walk between houses, which is the private property of the owners. It can be considered an invasion of privacy and a safety issue.
- Spring Cleaning: some of our <u>mailboxes</u>, <u>walkways</u> and <u>driveways</u> are in dire need of cleaning. This is the homeowner's responsibility. Do what is needed to help beautify our neighborhood.

Somethings to Consider: Tools for House Cleaning Success!

- To sanitize items, mix a bit of antibacterial dish soap with white vinegar in a bucket of hot water. Then use a rag to wipe doorknobs, doors, walls, and any areas of the house you want to disinfect and clean.
- A little bit of vinegar and water sprayed on vinyl floors makes them shine.
 Baking soda sprinkled in showers and sinks acts as a natural cleanser and deodorizer.
- Vinegar and baking soda mixed can freshen up drains and help clear clogs. Pour the baking soda over the drain, followed by vinegar. Rinse the bubbling mixture down the drain with boiling water.
- For glass shower doors with hard-water stains, vinegar will do the trick while leaving behind a streak-free surface.
- If you find it tricky to keep dark granite countertops smudge-free, use soapy water to wipe them down and then buff dry with a clean, dry microfiber cloth leaving the surface lint free.
- Other tools and products you can use are Mr. Clean, Magic Eraser, Febreze, Bon Ami (all-natural scouring powder), microfiber cloths, and pumice stones (to remove stains in the commode).
- Always give whatever cleaning solution you are using time to do its job. When you go to clean your shower, make sure you spray it and let it stand for a good 15-20 minutes before wiping it down.
- When it comes to dirt in nooks and crannies too small for hands to reach, toothpicks are a cleaner's best friend.
