-Holiday Decoration Reminder

-Holiday decorations are authorized in the bed areas only (trees and bushes) beginning the day after Thanksgiving through 15 January. Trimming of bushes and/or trees will cease during this time however, the mowing of lawns will continue. Lawn decorations inhibit the ability of the landscapers to mow and could harm the lawn. Owners are responsible for any damage caused by placing holiday decorations on their lawn.

- -Disposal of Live Christmas trees:
 - 1. Tree must not be larger than 6 feet in length; cut if necessary.
 - 3. Remove all decorations
 - 4. Breakdown all boxes before placing them in the garbage bin.
 - 5. Label side detailing what was in the box should not be exposed.

- -The first known basketball game was played on 21 December 1891




